## Keyboard Shortcut



Students help the KPAW Radio reporter decide which citizen's answer to broadcast from the responses to the question asked. Develops decoding skills, vocabulary development, sentence comprehension, conceptual relationships between words, understanding of semantics, syntax, phonology, morphology, and orthography, determining appropriate use of various homophones and homographs.

## Keyboard Shortcut



Students select tunes on the diner's jukebox by spelling words using the jukebox buttons. Develops spelling skills, letter-sound correspondences, phonemic awareness and vocabulary development


### Keyboard Shortcut:

## Keyboard Shortcut



Students help Stinky Bill place the missing words back on the billboard where they belong by selecting the correct word to fill in the appropriate blank spaces. Develops sentence comprehension, link between word meaning and sentence structure, vocabulary development and understanding of word structure.


### Keyboard Shortcut:

## Keyboard Shortcut



Students help Lulu and her friends finish sorting their clean laundry by selecting the correct word or punctuation mark that belongs in the displayed paragraph. Develops capitalization skills, use of correct punctuation marks and sentence and paragraph comprehension.



## Keyboard Shortcut



Students help the monkeys get the library back in order by putting the books back where they belong. Students answer questions about paragraphs, as well as schedules/tables, presented. Develops paragraph comprehension, understanding cause and effect, ability to make inferences, vocabulary development and working memory

### Keyboard Shortcut:


Start = Spacebar

## Keyboard Shortcut



Students choose the most appropriate paper for Mr. Goat to munch on, by selecting the paper with the sentence that matches the newsstand headlines. Develops sentence and paragraph comprehension, paraphrasing short paragraphs, vocabulary development, decoding and syntax skills, working memory and logical reasoning.
